



Born in 1894 in Karpnisi, Greece, Zack Touloupas immigrated to the United States in 1918. He initially moved here after he heard he could find \$20 gold pieces buried in the sand.

While living and working in several restaurants in Columbia, SC, he heard through the "Greek Grapevine" there was a restaurant for sale in Burlington, NC. Zack quickly bought "Alamance Hot Wienie Lunch", which was located on the corner of Front and Worth Streets. The original restaurant had only eight barstools and four school desks until renovation in 1960 increased the seating capacity to 44. That location was a local landmark until 1977, when Zack's moved to its present location.

The dollar bill that hangs behind the register was hand-woven in Greece, and also hung in the original location. It represents the first dollar that made at the restaurant.

John Touloupas started working at the restaurant with his father in 1946, and "Mr. Zack" continued to work until he was 88. In 1981, Zack Touloupas II joined his father to become the third generation to own and operate the restaurant. John continued to visit daily until his death in August of 2013...marking 67 years as a fixture in downtown Burlington.

Zack II and his wife, Sheila, continued the family tradition until the summer of 2022 - when they wrapped their last hot dogs and sold the restaurant to local businessman and entrepreneur, John Burton, and his son-in-law, Phillip Snyder.

However, as the logo now states, "**The Tradition Continues**", and the entire team is committed to maintaining the look, feel, taste and 'smell' that is easily identifiable as Zack's Hot Dogs. *Thank you for helping us keep the Zack's name and legacy going as downtown's most recognizable - and satisfying - restaurant.*
